A few days later Wilson came home neutered and "sporting" his new rabies tag. The other nice thing is that Wilson was Heartworm Negative, which means a much longer and healthier life. Sad to say but with the mosquito concentrations we have in this area most animals we see test Heartworm Positive.

Ryan, on his own, has volunteered to come by the shelter a couple of days a week and help to make sure that my many other friends know that they are loved as well.

Continued Care: Wilson is our first adoption. He left our care with a Six Months supply of Heartworm Chewables, a Microchip so we will always be able to identify him if he gets lost, the rest of his medication from Dr. Lea, a Bag of Science Diet Puppy Food and a bunch of kisses and pats on the head. We also made Ryan promise to bring Wilson by every couple of weeks since he has been and always will be a part of our family as well.

In addition, every month a Volunteer will call Ryan the day before to make sure Wilson gets his heartworm treatment and yearly when it is time for his rabies shot. And please mark your calendar for March 1st because that is Wilson's birthday and he loves Milk Bones.
