On Saturday, July 27th, you helped our alliance send 165 dogs, 10 cats and 2 pot belly pigs to loving homes located in States ranging from Virginia all the way to New Hampshire. All of these beautiful animals were scheduled to be euthanized in shelters throughout South Georgia.

The caravan left South Georgia at 6 pm on Saturday, July 27th, 2014. At 1 pm on Sunday, July 28th all of the dogs and cats had been received by hundreds of family members who were waiting for a beautiful animal to bring into their life that only a few moments before was just *'the next number on death's row'* at a shelter.

Every month this event will take place and anywhere from 150-225 dogs and cats who were scheduled to die will receive the blessing of life.

With your help we have been given opportunities that we would never have had. For this we extend our appreciation and our thanks.
