BLENDING INSTRUCTIONS NON-CAUSTIC DETERGENTS

When mixing, fill a clean poly drum approximately 60% full of warm water (approximately 100-120°F) and place the nozzle of a high pressure washer close to the bottom and continue filling while adding the product slowly. When the drum is full all of the powder should have been added.

USE INSTRUCTIONS:

Add 3 gallons of Emulsifier Plus to 2 gallons of bleach.

Mix with bleach on a job basis. Emulsifier Plus and bleach will separate after sitting together for a couple of days.
