## **APPLICATION**

Apply using an Allison Super Suds Sucker downstream injector. Part number: 1964

Work in small sections. For best results split the roof in quarters. This is a super concentrate even through an injector so apply just enough to get the roof good and wet. It is best not to let the product dry before you perform a quick 'dusting' light rinse.

If you are using a SHURflo or EVERflo pump pre-mix 1 gallon of product with 25 gallons of water. Spray on and lightly rinse.

## DWELL TIME

Final Phaze activates and locks into the surface upon contact. Large amounts are not required.

## **FOLLOW-UP COAT**

After one year it is recommended that you recontact the customer and schedule a follow-up service.

Note: as is the case with all cleaning and sealing products it is always safe to perform a test pattern first to make sure that the product is compatible with the surface. Often times you will be following a contractor who, in the past, has used cleaners that may react adversely with sealers and other cleaners.
