MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

All EnviroSpec Professional Detergents mix better and stay in solution longer than any other product in the industry. Simply open the reclosable lid and fill 75% of the bucket with water under very low pressure. Typical house pressure (40-50 PSI) is adequate.

If this product has a liquid additive add it when the bucket is 75% full. With the enclosed wooden 'stir' start mixing the product. In one circular motion along with an occasional 'back' (opposite direction) motion continue until product is in solution. If you are using warm water this process will generally take approximately 1 minute & with cold up to 2-4 minutes. Finish filling bucket. Product is ready to use.

Remember that all detergent powders mix better with warm water than they do with cold water. The water temperature should not exceed 120 degrees. If it does then you stand the chance of 'blowing apart' some of the product's surfactants.

If the product has become hard allow to sit in water a short while.

USE INSTRUCTIONS:

It is important to note that the peak performance of EnviroSpec detergents is achieved when applying the product at 160°. Anything over 160° typically results in diminished returns. Most detergents in the marketplace have to be applied at much higher temperatures simply because they do not contain the quantity or quality of performance driven surfactants that are found in our products.
